Thank you for volunteering to serve your nation as Member of Parliament for this constituency.

I wish to encourage you to promote measures that benefit the health and well-being of all Jamaicans. I therefore express my strong support for retaining and enacting laws and policies that protect the sanctity of life, marriage and family as traditionally defined.

In this respect, I stand for the following:

1. Retention of the definition of marriage under section 18 of the Charter of Fundamental Rights and Freedoms (Constitutional Amendment) Act, 2011, namely, the voluntary union of one man and one woman,
2. Age-appropriate sex education that is compatible with our laws and preserves the traditional distinction between male and female in accordance with the design of the human body,
3. Protection of religious liberties,
4. Retention of the laws against buggery and abortion,
5. Retention of the definition of sexual intercourse under section 2 of the Sexual Offences Act, 2009,
6. Maintaining or increasing the age of consent,
7. Respect for the constitutional right to life from conception to natural death.

I respectfully ask you to articulate these expressed positions on my behalf in your deliberations and meetings when speaking in your capacity as my political representative or member of the government. I also ask that these positions be used to inform policy positions when contemplating ministerial decisions and administrative actions.

I would appreciate receiving your written replies on these issues and look forward to further engagement with you on these issues.
